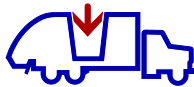

HELPFUL TRASH/RECYCLING GUIDELINES

In an effort to reduce or eliminate potential trash/recycling related problems at Churchill Village-South, this reminder is to help acquaint you with the appropriate disposal methods.

REGULAR TRASH COLLECTION:



- Regular trash collection days are **MONDAYS AND THURSDAYS**.

Regular collections will be made by Ecology Services (301/330-3207) when a holiday falls on a Monday or Thursday, **EXCEPT that NO COLLECTIONS WILL BE MADE ON:**

**THANKSGIVING DAY
CHRISTMAS DAY NEW YEARS DAY.**

Collection after these holidays will be made on the **NEXT REGULAR COLLECTION DAY**.

- The collection point for trash is:**

The curb nearest the front of your home. If you are on a pipestem driveway, please place your trash container at the curb on the public street.

Move-In Trash (boxes, etc.) - By Montgomery County law, all boxes must be flattened, bundled and placed out for **recycling collection**. Paper from packing should also be bundled for recycling or placed in an appropriate recycling container. The trash company may not take such items.

If there are "bulk" items such as old furniture, etc. or if you will have more than 3-4 bags of trash per house, please call Ecology Services at (301)330-3207 or Montgomery County (see web site) to arrange for a special collection.

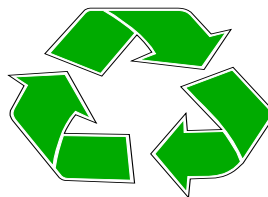
- Trash should be kept in tightly **sealed** metal or rubber containers. These containers should be placed out for collection.

Please Note: Trash **should never be stored** in plastic or paper bags as these do not securely enclose the garbage and create unclean and potentially unsanitary conditions that will ultimately cost everyone for clean-up!

* **IMPORTANT**

- ▶ **Trash containers should not be placed out in public view, except on days of collection.**
- ▶ **Trash containers should be stored in your rear yard, in your garage or inside the home, except on days of collection.**

- **PLEASE DO NOT** place large furniture items out for the regular trash collections as the trash company will not remove this type of item. If you have a large item such as a mattress or sofa that needs immediate disposal, please contact Ecology Services at (301)330-3207 or contact Montgomery County (see web site) to arrange for a special pick-up.
- **PLEASE DO NOT PLACE HAZARDOUS MATERIALS SUCH AS PAINT, OILS, OR OTHER SIMILAR ITEMS IN THE TRASH!** It is against Montgomery County law to dispose of such items in the regular trash. Individual owners/residents must dispose of these materials at the County Transfer Station in Gaithersburg or at those special collection points advertised by the County. RECYCLING COLLECTION:

Recycling collection is performed by a contractor hired by the Montgomery County government.

- The regular recycling collection day is **MONDAY**.
- Recyclables must be placed in the "blue bin" provided by Montgomery County. Go to www.montgomerycountymd.gov/solidwaste.
- Recycling collection is provided by a contractor for Montgomery County and the collection point is at the FRONT curb for all homes.

Recyclable materials include:
